Fish species commonly affected include carp, tilapia, eel, catfish, salmon and trout. Many potentially pathogenic bacteria of fish normally exist in a commensal association with the host or live free in the environment. Both these types of bacteria become pathogenic when the fish is immunocompromised by some form of stressors. Human infections caused by pathogens transmitted from fish or the aquatic environment are quite common and depend on the patients, contact with fish and related environment, dietary habits and the immune system status of the exposed individual. They are often bacterial species facultative pathogenic for both fish and human beings and may be isolated from fish without apparent symptoms of the disease.
